



Mario Rinvoluceri on becoming a language teacher...

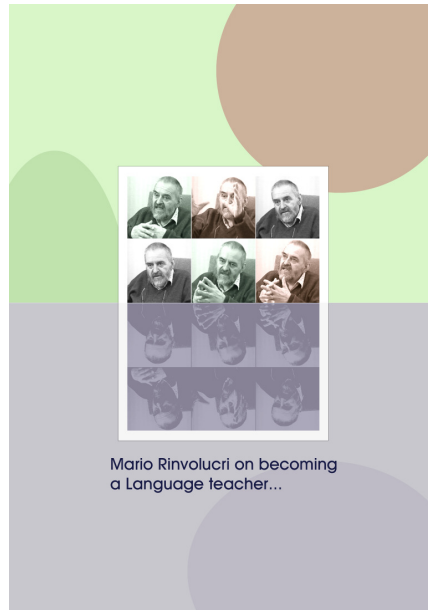
"Mario Rinvoluceri on becoming a language teacher" is an interactive video interview. Rinvoluceri is one of the most productive language teachers of the past few decades. He has written several books in this field and currently trains English teachers at Pilgrims, a language school in Canterbury, England.

The programme contains 26 questions and answers where Mario Rinvoluceri talks about various education-related subjects, for example, his own background and career, his teachers, and teaching principles. He also analyses the

benefits of different teaching material and methods, and the state of language instruction in Europe and elsewhere in the world.

The context of the programme should interest both language teachers and anyone preparing to be a teacher.

The programme "Mario Rinvoluceri on becoming a language teacher" contains complete transcripts of all the video material, which makes it a diverse tool for both teaching and learning.



PC CD requires: MS Windows (Win95/98, NT, 2000, Me, XP) PC with an audio card and speakers or headphones.

Listening to a native speaker, the user is exposed to natural hesitations and idiomatic expressions. In addition to the interesting content in the interview videos, the user hears spoken language in a natural context and how Rinvoluceri expresses and substantiates his opinion.

The programme also contains a useful teachers' guide which has concrete ideas about using the video material in teaching and a list of applicable exercises.
